Research Analysis

HB 2317, as introduced, establishes a grievance process for children detained in an adult facility. The Office of Juvenile System Oversight shall receive grievances for investigation, resolution, and referrals, if appropriate. Each facility in which children are held shall make grievance policies and procedures available upon public request and make resources readily accessible to children in the facility as well as explain the policies upon intake. These provisions do not apply to children housed in a Department of Corrections facility or housed under a Department of Corrections contract.
