Research Analysis

Committee amendment1 to HB 2323 prohibits an insurer or a preferred provider organization (PPO) from unilaterally removing a provider from the network for certain reasons.

The measure permits insurers to allow contracts to expire on its own terms or to negotiate new contracts with the provider at the end of contract term. A provider agreement is prohibited from restricting, penalizing, or terminating a preferred provider from referring to an out-of-network provider, provided the insured signs an acknowledgement of referral that the insured may incur certain charges, deductibles, and higher coinsurance.
