Research Analysis

Floor Substitute 2 to HB 2350 creates a Task Force on State Data Storage and Retrieval Systems. The task force would be required to submit an annual report regarding storage of personal information, including an overview of data maintained by state governmental entities, opportunities to consolidate duplicated data into a central repository, and recommendations for maintenance or enhancement of the central data repository. The task force would also include in its initial report recommendations on the ability of agencies, boards and commissions to access information about a person or business from other agencies and whether that access is consistent with privacy standards or laws.

KEY DIFFERENCES BETWEEN FLOOR VERSION AND FLOOR SUBSTITUTE:

1. Changes in the membership of the Task Force—removing Corporation Commission, Securities Commission, OSBI and OSBNDD and adding State Treasurer; Auditor and Inspector and State Department of Education;
2. Qualification language for both the chair and vice-chair has been added;
3. The CIO is disqualified from being chair or vice-chair but the OMES appointees are not disqualified;
4. Change in number of required meetings per year from two to four;
5. New subsection H excludes the judicial and legislative branches from the scope of the Task Force powers/analysis;
6. Change in final report date to April, 2023.
