Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2351 stipulates that within sixty (60) days of the start of each placement of a child in a qualified residential treatment program, the court must conduct a hearing to consider the assessment made by the qualified individual conducting the assessment as part of the Department's written report, determine whether the needs of a child could be met through foster home placement or if the best care is in a qualified residential treatment program, and determine whether placement is consistent with the goals for the child, and then approve or disapprove the placement.
