The proposed committee substitute to HB 2361 adds an additional cause which allows for the removal of a public officer. The measure adds habitual absence from minimum required training events.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2361 deletes a removable offense from the original version. It also removes the provision that a district attorney shall investigate complaints against the official.

The proposed committee substitute alters the impact of the introduced version. By removing the fineable offenses and eliminating the investigatory mandate of the district attorney, the measure would now have no anticipated direct impact on state revenues or expenditures.
