Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 2380 allows alcoholic beverage licensees to provide self-pour automated devices for dispensing beer and wine. In order for a patron to use the self-pour service, they must obtain an RFID device or other ABLE Commission-approved technology from the licensee, which will give the patron a credit to dispense 10 ounces of wine or 32 ounces of beer. Licensees are required to provide constant video monitoring at all times during which the licensee is open, keep such footage for at least 60 days, and provide the footage upon request to any ABLE Commission agent or other authorized law enforcement.

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 2380 allows alcoholic beverage license holders to offer self-pour service from automated devices if certain requirements are met.
