## **Research Analysis**

HB 2402, as introduced, allows a county, municipality, public trust, conservancy district or any other political subdivision operating a public water supply system or wastewater treatment system to utilize design-build as a project delivery method for those water systems. *Design-build* is defined as a project delivery method in which one entity works under a single contract to provide design and construction services. The measure requires the Department of Environmental Quality to incorporate a flexible permitting process to allow this design-build authorization into its rules and to authorize up to 5 pilot projects in the interim before those rules are adopted.
