**Research Analysis**

HB 2446, as introduced, modifies the duties of the Office of Juvenile Offenders to include that they are responsible for programs and services for youthful offenders as well as juveniles. Additionally, the Executive Director shall be responsible for established divisions and appointing directors. This bill eliminates statutory language on the duties and director appointment process for divisions in the Office of Juvenile Affairs including Institutional Services, Community-based Youth Services, and Juvenile and Treatment Services.
