Research Analysis

HB 2532 creates the 13-member Criminal Justice Coordinating Commission to study, evaluate and make recommendations concerning the creation of diversion programs, including alternative sentencing, supervision and treatment options for defendants who commit simple possession crimes. The Commission is submit a report to the Legislature by February 1 each year. Staffing for the Commission is to be provided by the Office of the Attorney General.
