## **Research Analysis**

HB 2542 authorizes the admission of an attorney on a motion to practice law under certain circumstances. The measure allows an applicant, upon motion, be admitted to the practice of law in Oklahoma if the applicant:

1. Is a graduate of a law school approved by the American Bar Association;

2. Has been admitted to practice law in another state, territory or the District of Columbia;

3. Is a member in good standing on active status in a reciprocal state;

4. Establishes that the applicant is not currently subject to lawyer discipline or the subject of a pending disciplinary matter in any jurisdiction;

5. Has been engaged in the practice of law for a period of five of the seven years immediately preceding the date upon which the application is filed; and

6. Establishes that the applicant possesses the character and fitness to practice law in this state.
