Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 2588 allows a board of education of a school district to adopt a policy to authorized the carrying of a handgun onto school property by school personnel if the person possesses a valid handgun license and meets other requirements authorized by the board of education.

The Floor Substitute to HB 2588:

Sections 1, 2 & 3: Require handgun licensees to also have 4 hours of weapon retention training and demonstrated proficiency in handgun training and campus-specific active shooter training

Section 1: Require biannual training

Section 3: Require ongoing continuing education

Added July 1 effective date & emergency clause.
