**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 2595 adds language to the bill in Section 1 that requires a physical therapist who treats a patient without a referral to obtain a signed disclosure form from the patient that acknowledges certain limitations of physical therapy treatment. It also acknowledges that physical therapy services may not be covered by the patient's health insurance.
