## **Research Analysis**

HB 2644 extends the date to which a public body may hold meetings by teleconference or videoconference to March 31, 2024. The measure provides that a public body which gives public notice of any meeting for which there will be a videoconference option shall not modify the method of meeting described in the notice prior to the meeting and shall conduct the meeting according to the methods described in the notice. Any code or password that is required to log into the videoconference meeting must be included in the meeting notice.
