**Research Analysis**

The second proposed committee substitute for HB 2659 allows medical marijuana patient licensees to legally possess marijuana harvested from six mature marijuana plants, as well as 72 ounces of topical marijuana.

Additionally, the measure amends the definition of *dispensary* to authorize dispensaries to prepare and package non-infused, pre-rolled medical marijuana, as well as purchase products from and sell or transfer products to other dispensaries.
