Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2660 splits the medical marijuana processor license into two categories: nonvolatile, which involves using any solvent in the extraction process that is not volatile, and volatile, which involves using any solvent that is or produces a flammable gas or vapor that will create explosive or ignitable mixtures when present in the air in sufficient quantities.

The measure also increases, from 10 pounds to 50 pounds, the amount of usable marijuana a grower shall separate into harvest batches. The measure decreases, from 10 pounds to 2 pounds, the amount of distillate a processor shall separate into production batches. For final products, which are defined in the measure to include but not be limited to cookies, brownies, candies, gummies and chocolates, the maximum batch size is 50,000 milligrams of THC.
