Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2665 separates the alcoholic beverage manufacturer license from the nonresident seller license and sets its fees as the following:

- 50 cases or less sold in Oklahoma in the last calendar year: \$50 licensing fee and additional \$100 annual fee
- 51 to 500 cases sold in Oklahoma in the last calendar year: \$75 licensing fee and additional \$225 annual fee
- 501 cases or more sold in Oklahoma in the last calendar year: \$150 licensing fee and additional \$450 annual fee

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 2665 establishes an alcoholic beverage manufacturer license and associated fees.

Upon review and with consultation from the Alcoholic Beverage Law Enforcement Commission, the measure is determined to have a potential positive revenue impact to the state depending on the number of licenses issued.
