## **Research Analysis**

HB2673, as introduced, modifies the Education Open Transfer Act. The measure requires a school district to establish availability prior to approving any student transfer into the district. Upon approval of a transfer, the receiving district will claim the student in the average daily membership and assume all responsibility for educating the student.

HB2673 also creates a new funding weight of 1.1 for students enrolled at a school that has received an "F" on the State A-F Report Card for the previous three years. Lastly, the measure allows a student enrolled in a resident school that has received an "F" for the past three years to be granted an emergency transfer.
