Research Analysis

The floor amendment to HB2727 deletes language that allowed school districts to partner with nonprofits or private organizations to provide Adulting 101 instruction.

The Amendment adds language allowing Adulting 101 curriculum to be taught through a Family and Consumer Science course or other applicable courses.

Any teacher teaching Adulting 101 is not required to have specialized certification.

Lastly, the amendment requires schools to follow LEAD FCS standards when implementing the course.
