Research Analysis

HB 2730 defines the following terms: Implicit bias; and Implicit stereotypes. The measure requires hospitals and birthing centers that provide inpatient maternity services to implement an implicit bias training program for health professionals who provide perinatal treatment and care.

The measure provides curriculum for the implicit bias training program. Certain health care professionals are required to meet the conditions of the training program. The measure directs the State Department of Health to promulgate rules and to track results of the training program.
