HB 2746 exempts municipal or state law enforcement officers employed in a county with a population of more than 255,000 and federal law enforcement officers from jury duty. The measure provides that municipal or state law enforcement officers in counties with a population of less than 255,000 may serve on noncriminal actions only.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2746, as introduced, provides that municipal or state law enforcement officers employed in any county with a population of 255,000 or more and federal law enforcement officers are not qualified to serve as jurors.

The measure further provides that municipal or state law enforcement officers in a county with a population of less than 255,000 are eligible as jurors for noncriminal actions only.

No direct impact to state revenues or expenditures is anticipated from passage of the measure.
