Research Analysis

HB2750, as introduced, requires colleges and universities within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education to grant course credit to students who score a 3 or higher on an Advanced Placement exam.

Colleges and universities must post their credit policy regarding Advanced Placement exams on their websites, beginning with the 2021-2022 fall academic term. They must also conduct biennial reviews of their Advanced Placement credit policy.
