Research Analysis

HB2752, as introduced, requires the State Department of Education (SDE) to establish microcredentials for teachers in the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM).

The measure requires the SDE, in consultation with the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability to convene a working group to determine how such micro-credentials will be used.

A micro-credential in STEM shall be used to exempt a teacher from the corresponding subject area competency exams, and corresponding professional development requirements.
