Research Analysis

HB2752, as introduced, requires the State Department of Education (SDE) to establish micro-credentials for teachers in the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM).

The measure requires the SDE, in consultation with the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability to convene a working group to determine how such micro-credentials will be used.

A micro-credential in STEM shall be used to exempt a teacher from the corresponding subject area competency exams, and corresponding professional development requirements.
