**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 2773 modifies the requirements for members of the Pardon and Parole Board. The measure states that a member of the Pardon and Parole Board must uphold and promote independence, impartiality, fairness, and integrity of the Board and should avoid impropriety or the appearance of impropriety. A member of the Board who determines that circumstances would cause a reasonable person with knowledge of all the relevant facts would question the board members impartiality the board member must disclose any potential conflict of interest and withdraw from participation in the matter.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2773 modifies the requirements for members of the Pardon and Parole Board. The measure requires Board members to disclose potential conflicts of interest when circumstances would cause a reasonable person to question the impartiality of members.
