**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB2890 allows school districts to have an excess in their general fund carryover for fiscal years 2020-2023 and not be penalized.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure permits school district to carryover a general balance fund in excess of limits previously established by law without a general fund penalty being assessed. The measure allows districts to continue this practice through FY 2023. Additionally, the measure provides that the July calculation of per pupil revenue be determined by the district's second preceding year's total average daily membership (ADM).
