Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 2908 requires the Department of Corrections to use \$8 million to improve the correctional officer to inmate ratio at correctional facilities; \$9.24 million for hepatitis C treatment; \$1.8 million for a contractual per diem increase at the Lawton Correctional and Rehabilitation Facility; and designates \$9,235,258 for transfer to the Department of Corrections Offender Management System Revolving Fund created in HB 2909.

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to the measure requires the expenditure of FY-2022 appropriations to the Department of Corrections on certain purposes as follows:

- \$8,000,000 to improve the correctional officer to inmate ratio at correctional facilities.
- \$9,240,000 for hepatitis C treatment.
- \$1,800,000 for a contractual per diem increase at the Lawton Correctional and Rehabilitation Facility.
- Designates \$9,235,258 for transfer to the Department of Corrections Offender Management System Revolving Fund, created in the proposed committee substitute to HB 2909.
