**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to the measure requires the expenditure of FY-2022 appropriations to the Department of Corrections on certain purposes as follows:

- \$8,000,000 to improve the correctional officer to inmate ratio at correctional facilities.
- \$9,240,000 for hepatitis C treatment.
- \$1,800,000 for a contractual per diem increase at the Lawton Correctional and Rehabilitation Facility.
- Designates \$9,235,258 for transfer to the Department of Corrections Offender Management System Revolving Fund, created in the proposed committee substitute to HB 2909.
