## **Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2950 creates the Ambulance Service Provider Access Payment Program Act, which directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to, upon recommendation of the Oklahoma Ambulance Alliance, to assess Oklahoma-licensed ambulance service providers a fee. Monies received pursuant to this fee shall be deposited in the newly created Ambulance Service Provider Access Payment Fund. The measure specifies how the monies in the fund are to be used, provides for implementation and lists exempt entities.
