## **Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3005 specifies that any person who receives, transports, or possesses a stolen automotive catalytic converter or components thereof will, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by not less than 1 year nor more than 5 years imprisonment, or confined in the county jail for term of not less than 90 days nor more than 200 days, a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 or both fine and imprisonment. Lastly, the bill provides the circumstances to consider when a buyer makes an inquiry about the legal right to sell or deliver an automotive catalytic converter.
