Research Analysis

HB 3005 specifies that any person who receives, transports, or possesses a stolen automotive catalytic converter or components thereof will, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony. The measure provides the penalties for such conviction. HB 3005 also specifies that the buyer is presumed to have bought the property with knowledge that such property is stolen or wrongfully obtained. The measure allows the presumption to be rebutted by proof. Lastly, the bill provides the circumstances to consider when a buyer makes an inquiry about the legal right to sell or deliver an automotive catalytic converter.
