Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3015 Fiscal Impact

House Bill 3015 will require adult-size changing tables in Tourism Information Center (TIC) family or assisted-use toilet and bathing rooms for the assistance of persons with disabilities. The changing station must be equipped with a height-adjustable changing table suitable for an adult or child. All TICs must comply by January 1, 2028.

Table Requirements

The requirements listed in the House Bill are restrictive and the among the biggest tables made for changing stations.

- At least 24"x70"
- Adjustable from 8" to 34"
- Support 350 pounds

Cost of Compliance

There are eight (8) family restrooms that would qualify for an adult size changing table at the TIC facilities. The estimated cost per unit is \$10,000 due to the requirements. There are construction and installation cost that are unknown without a structural review of the buildings. The total cost for purchase and installation of the tables is \$128,000.
