Research Analysis

The CS for HB 3021 modifies the definition of "judge of competent jurisdiction" in the terms used in the Security of Communications Act. The term currently refers to the presiding judge of the Court of Criminal Appeals. The measure allows the presiding judge to designate another member of the Court of Criminal Appeals to serve in this capacity. In addition, the measure modifies the Security Communications Act to require the judge of competent jurisdiction to file a report with the Clerk of the Court of Criminal Appeals, rather than the Administrative Director of the Courts.

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to the measure modifies the process for the submission and record keeping of wiretap orders.

Upon review and with consultation from both the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and the Administrative Office of the Courts, no direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure.
