Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB3038 makes modifications to the state's open transfer policy for public schools.

The measure:

- Allows a district to accept any brother or sister of a transfer student regardless of capacity if the district's policy gives preference to sibling transfers;
- Requires a district to accept the transfer of a child whose parent or guardian is a district employee regardless of capacity, if the district transfer policy gives preference to employee's children;
- Allows a receiving district to give priority to a student transfer regardless of capacity if the student was a resident student for at least three years but moved out of the district;
- Clarifies that transferred students may automatically continue to attend the school they have transferred to after their first year.
