Research Analysis

HB3038, as introduced, makes modifications to the state's open transfer policy for public schools. The measure allows a district to accept any brother or sister of a transfer student, regardless of capacity, if the district's policy gives preference to sibling transfers. Students may also be allowed to transfer to the district in which a parent or guardian is employed, regardless of capacity, if the district's transfer policy grants this.

Lastly, the measure clarifies that transferred students may automatically continue to attend the school they have transferred to after their first year.
