Research Analysis

The conference committee substitute to HB3056 authorizes municipalities, who are both subject to and exempt from the Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act, to enact a comprehensive code of campaign finance and personal disclosure ordinances including policies and provision for the administration and enforcement of such ordinances. Municipalities enacting their own ordinances may contract with an interlocal entity for administration and enforcement. If necessary, municipal governments may provide for a hearing and enforcement, however civil fines can not exceed \$500. The measure also states that the Ethics Commission should have no enforcement responsibilities.
