**Municipal Impact: Minimal or No Impact**

**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 3062 allows for municipalities to publish notices and publications, that are required by law to be published in a newspaper, on a website maintained by or on behalf of the city or town for the same required period of time it was to be published in a newspaper. The measure also establishes that no power interruption or hardware or software failures related to the website, computer system, or portable device used to access the website can be used to invalidate the publishing of the notice or publication.
