**Research Analysis**

HB 3078 provides that if a correctional officer accrues overtime and the overtime is compensable, the Department of Corrections may make payment for the overtime compensation not later than the fifteenth day of the month if the correctional officer elects to receive the payment at that time. Correctional officers are required to make an election with regard to the timing of overtime payments which is binding for six months at which time the election may either be renewed or, if not renewed, overtime payments are to be made at the same time as other payments for wages.
