HB 3087 provides that authorized personnel of a jail who have deemed a person medically unfit to be received into custody at the jail may not be considered in violation of a duty to fingerprint any person received into custody as a prisoner.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as introduced, would allow authorized personnel of jails to refuse to receive persons that such personnel have deemed medically unfit to be received into custody. The measure would also extend this provision to the fingerprinting of persons.
