**Research Analysis**

HB 3132 allows the governing body of any municipality, public ambulance service districts, or emergency medical service districts to enter into agreements with local first responder agencies for the purpose of acquiring assistance with emergency medical response. The measure provides certain conditions for agreements with first responder agencies.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure provides permissive language for any municipality, public ambulance service district or emergency medical service district to enter into agreements with local first responder agencies for assistance with emergency medical response.

The provision is permissive in nature, allowing entities to elect to enter into such agreements. Any revenue or fiscal costs or savings to an eligible entity will depend on the structure and terms of any such agreement.
