Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB3133 requires county sheriffs of the arresting agency, their designee, any peace officer, contractors with OJA, or juvenile court officers to provide for the transportation of juveniles to and from secure detention for the purposes of admission, interfacility transfer, discharge, medical or dental attention, court appearance, or office-designated transfer.

HB3133 also changes related fees included raising the fee for the cost of personal services to \$17 per hour, the fee for meals for transporting personnel not to exceed \$10 per meal, and the fees for meals for juveniles being transported to \$10 per meal.
