**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3145 prohibits a person having a communicable disease from attending a private, charter, or public school. It will be the duty of the parent or guardian to exclude such person from the school in compliance with the school's quarantine protocols until the expiration of the period of isolation or until permission to do so will have been given by the local county health department or the State Department of Health.

The CS requires school boards to promulgate quarantine protocols in conjunction with local health authorities and the State Department of Health. The measure amends 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-505 and repeals Sections 1-506 and 1-507 in its entirety.
