**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute 2 to HB 3145 prohibits compelling a person suspected or having a communicable disease to be moved from the place where he or she is sick to any place other than his or her own residence unless the individual does not reside in a permanent residence. The measure also provides that any person having a communicable disease may be prohibited from attending a private, public, or parochial school. It will be the duty of the parent or guardian to exclude such person from the school in compliance with the school's communicable disease policy. FA2 requires school boards to make communicable disease policy in conjunction with local health department authorities and the State Department of Health. The measure repeals 63 O.S. 2021, Sections 1-506 and 1-507 in its entirety.
