Research Analysis

HB3150, as introduced, requires regulated utility entities, subject to the February 2021 Regulated Utility Consumer Protection Act, to disclose any extreme purchase costs incurred during February 7, 2021 through February 21, 2021. The measure also requires these utilities to include a statement on customers' bills detailing the dollar amount the customer would have been required to pay had the February 2021 Regulated Utility Consumer Protection Act not been put in place. Further, customers' bills are required to include a statement showing any charges associated with the extreme weather event, and the date when those charges will be paid in full.
