**Research Analysis**

The amendment to HB3154 specifies that any entity must provide written notice to every registered voter eligible to vote in the upcoming election except for franchise elections described in Sections 5(a) and 5(b) of Article XVIII of the Oklahoma Constitution.

HB3154 requires any entity calling an election, except for franchise elections, to provide written notice to every registered voter eligible to vote in the upcoming election providing the date of the election and a website allowing the voter to view the content of the ballot.
