**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB3193 restores the original language in 2a and 2b in paragraph D.

HB3193 determines that the father of an unwed couple will be listed on a birth certificate if the both parents agree on the biological paternity of the child. Mother and father will have equal rights and obligations to the child and the child will be treated as a child whose parents were married at the time of birth.
