**Research Analysis**

HB 3208 directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) to establish a two-year moratorium on issuing business licenses for dispensaries, processors, and commercial growers beginning July 1, 2022. The moratorium does not apply to licensure renewal or applications received on or before July 1, 2022. Additionally, the measure prohibits change in ownership of a business if the licensee has a current violation that may necessitate revocation, suspension, or nonrenewal of the license.
