Research Analysis

The floor amendment to HB 3216 strikes the requirement that utilization review of an emergency care claim must be performed by a physician who is licensed to practice medicine in Oklahoma.

FA1 specifies conditions deemed an unfair method of competition or an unfair or deceptive act in the business of insurance for an insurer, individual or entity. Utilization review of an emergency care claim must be performed by a physician board certified in emergency medicine. FA1 also provides the conditions for a utilization review agent and defines "emergency care" in the act.

According to the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this measure does not create a fiscal impact for OID.
