**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB3276 provides qualified immunity to law enforcement officers and their employers for claims brought under the Governmental Tort Claims Act when the alleged conduct isn't clearly established as a violation of the law. The measure also provides that any decision by a district court denying qualified immunity is immediately appealable and any claim where a plaintiff fails to plead a plausible violation of law will result in dismissal with prejudice.
