Research Analysis

HB 3302 provides that when the Director of the Department of Corrections fails to declare an emergency due to shortage of staff and a shift supervisor requires a correctional officer to work more than two double shifts in a seven-day period, the shift supervisor shall be suspended, without pay.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as introduced, would require the suspension of shift supervisors employed by the Department of Corrections if they require a correctional officer to work more than two double shifts in a seven-day period without a declared emergency by the Director of the Department of Corrections.

Upon review, no direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure. The measure stipulates that shift supervisors suspended under the provisions of the measure are suspended without pay.
