## **Research Analysis**

HB3321 adds that the Secretary of the State Election Board may use the Social Security Administration master death index list if the multistate voter list maintenance organization provides access. Additionally, all ballots used for an election must be paper with options for blind or visually impaired voters. For any election after July 1, 2022, each county election board must report the results by precinct. Election watchers must be present in-person. The bill prohibits any devices or equipment used to count votes from connecting to the internet. The measure also includes distributing an absentee ballot application or request to a voter with official letterhead under the definition of "absentee ballot harvesting."

## **Fiscal Analysis**

Upon review and with consultation from the State Election Board, passage of the measure may have a fiscal impact.
